- Prior Conviction Levels for Misdemeanor Sentencing. The prior conviction "(b) levels for misdemeanor sentencing are:
  - Level  $\frac{1}{4}A 0$  prior convictions. (1)
  - Level HB At least 1, but not more than 4 prior convictions. (2)
  - Level HIC At least 5 prior convictions." (3)
