2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE FACILITATION AND ASSISTANCE
3	GRANT FUND TO SUPPORT A CONSERVATION EASEMENTS PROGRAM
4	FOR THE PROTECTION OF NATURAL RESOURCES, AS RECOMMENDED
5	BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Facilitation and
8	Assistance Grant Fund created by G.S. 113A-232, if enacted by the General Assembly,
9	the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and the
10	sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to
11	implement the provisions of the act that creates that Fund. There is appropriated from the
12	General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum
13	of two hundred twenty-two thousand eight hundred and six dollars (\$222,806) for the
14	1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred seven thousand three hundred and six
15	dollars (\$207,306) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to establish and support the positions of
16	Conservation Tax Credit Program Administrator and Administrative Assistant, which
17	positions shall implement the Conservation Easements Program, if enacted by the
18	General Assembly.
19	Section 2. This act becomes effective 1 July 1997.
