A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO EXTEND THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES COMMISSION TO ALL OF JONES, WILMINGTON, AND SALISBURY STREETS PROXIMATE TO THE STATE LEGISLATIVE BUILDING, AND TO THE BRICK WALKWAY PROXIMATE TO THE LEGISLATIVE OFFICE BUILDING.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. G.S. 120-32.1(d) reads as rewritten:
"(d) For the purposes of this section, the term "State legislative buildings and
grounds"means:
(1) At all times:
a. The State Legislative Building;
al. The areas between the outer walls of the State Legislative
Building and the near curbline of those sections of Jones

14		_	Government Mall, described as follows: beginning at the
15			northeast corner of the Legislative Office Building, thence east
16			across the brick sidewalk to the inner edge of the sidewalk
17			adjacent to the grassy area of the Mall, thence south along the
18			inner edge of the sidewalk to the southwest outer corner of the
19			Mall water fountain, thence east along the southern outer edge of
20			the fountain to a point north of the northeast corner of the
21			pedestrian surface of the Lane Street pedestrian bridge, thence
22			south from that point to the northeast corner of the pedestrian
23			surface of the bridge, thence west along the southern edge of the
24			brick sidewalk area of the Mall to the southeast corner of the
25			Legislative Office Building, thence north along the east wall of
26			the Legislative Office Building, to the point of beginning.

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
