2	AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO
3	STUDY THE NONBANKING CONSUMER INDUSTRIES REGULATED BY THE
4	OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF BANKS.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the nonbanking
7	consumer industries regulated by the Office of the Commissioner of Banks, including,
8	consumer finance lenders, money transmitters, mortgage brokers and bankers, refund
9	anticipation lenders, and reverse mortgage lenders.
10	Section 2. The Commission may make an interim report to the 1998 Regular
11	Session of the 1997 General Assembly and a final report, including any legislative
12	proposals, to the 1999 General Assembly.

13 Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
