5	APPLICATION FEE FOR NONPUBLIC ASSISTANCE CHILD SUPPORT
6	ENFORCEMENT SERVICES.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	Section 1. Effective 30 days after this act becomes law, the Department of
9	Human Resources shall not elect any child support distribution option for families
10	receiving cash assistance under the State Plan for the Temporary Assistance for Needy
11	Families (TANF) Block Grant Program for which the federal government does not
12	provide funding to the State to exercise the option.
13	Section 2. G.S. 110-130.1(a) reads as rewritten:
14	"(a) All child support collection and paternity determination services provided
15	under this Article to recipients of public assistance shall be made available to any
16	individual not receiving public assistance in accordance with federal law and as
17	contractually authorized by the nonrecipient, upon proper application and payment of a
18	nonrefundable application fee of ten dollars (\$10.00)twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)."



Section 3. Section 1 of this act is effective when it becomes law. Section 2 of
this act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
