A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE MECKLENBURG COUNTY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE 3 CONTROL BOARD TO PROVIDE ITS OWN LAW ENFORCEMENT 4 PERSONNEL AND TO CONTRACT FOR ADDITIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 18B-501(f) reads as rewritten:

- Contracts with Other Agencies. Instead of of, or in addition to, hiring local ABC officers, a local board may contract to pay its enforcement funds to with a sheriff's department, city police department, or other local law-enforcement agency for enforcement of the ABC laws within the law-enforcement agency's territorial jurisdiction. Enforcement agreements may be made with more than one agency at the same time.
- When such a contract for enforcement exists, the those officers of the contracting law-13
- enforcement agency designated in the contract shall have the same authority to inspect 14
- under G.S. 18B-502 that an ABC officer employed by that local board would have. once 15
- the designated officers of the contracting law enforcement agency have been certified by 16

- the chief ABC officer as having been trained. In order to be certified, the designated 1 2 officers shall receive the same training in the enforcement of the ABC laws as is provided 3 to local ABC officers. If a city located in two or more counties approves the sale of some 4 type of alcoholic beverage pursuant to the provisions of G.S. 18B-600(e4), and there are 5 no local ABC boards established in the city and one of the counties in which the city is 6 located, the local ABC board of any county in which the city is located may enter into an 7 enforcement agreement with the city's police department for enforcement of the ABC 8 laws within the entire city, including that portion of the city located in the county of the 9 ABC board entering into the enforcement agreement. Enforcement agreements 10 authorized by this section may be cancelled by the local ABC board upon 20 days' written notice. 11
 - Payments, if any, received by a contracting agency for furnishing law enforcement services shall be in addition to any profits allocated to local governments derived from the sale of alcoholic beverages."
 - Section 2. This act applies to the Mecklenburg County Alcoholic Beverage Control Board only.
 - Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
