4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. Part 3 of Article 1 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is
6	amended by adding a new section to read:
7	" <u>§ 116-40.6. Admission requirements for Article 39 students.</u>
8	If the transcript of an individual applying for admission to a constituent institution
9	from a school lawfully operating under Article 39 of Chapter 115C of the General
10	Statutes reflects that the applicant has met the Board of Governor's minimum admission
11	requirements, the applicant shall not be required to take additional tests as a condition of
12	application for admission. This section shall not be construed to preclude the constituent
13	institutions from requiring that applicants from schools lawfully operated under Article
14	39 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes take, as a condition of admission, the same
15	college entrance exams that are required of all applicants for admission."
