Referred to: Appropriations. May 21, 1998 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR LOW-WEALTH SCHOOL SYSTEMS' SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of fifty-three million six hundred forty-three thousand three hundred forty-three dollars (\$53,643,343) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for low-wealth school systems' supplemental funding. It is a goal of the General Assembly to provide supplemental funds to lowwealth counties to allow those counties to enhance the instructional program and student achievement. Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
