A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE AN ADDITIONAL MAGISTRATE FOR FRANKLIN COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 7A-133(c) reads as rewritten:

"(c) Each county shall have the numbers of magistrates and additional seats of district court, as set forth in the following table:
