March 13, 1997 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ST. MARK'S, INCORPORATED, FOR CAPITAL EXPENSES IN BUILDING A REGIONAL FACILITY TO SERVE CHILDREN WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to St. Mark's, Incorporated, a nonprofit corporation, the sum of one million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$1,700,000) for the 1997-98 fiscal year for capital costs in building a new preschool facility to serve children with developmental disabilities from Mecklenburg, Union, and Anson Counties. Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
