A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE TOWN OF WILLIAMSTON TO EXERCISE EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OVER AN AREA EXTENDING TWO MILES FROM ITS LIMITS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding G.S. 160A-360(a), with the approval of the county board of commissioners, the Town of Williamston may exercise the powers granted in Article 19 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes over an area extending not more than two miles beyond its limits.

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
