Referred to: Children & Human Resources March 25, 1997 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND THE GENERAL STATUTES CONCERNING THE DETECTION, PREVENTION, CARE, AND TREATMENT OF GLAUCOMA. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. The title to Part 3 of Article 7 of Chapter 130A of the General Statutes reads as rewritten: "PART 3. GLAUCOMA AND DIABETES." Section 2. G.S. 130A-221 reads as rewritten: "§ 130A-221. Department to establish program. The Department shall establish and administer a program for the detection and (a) prevention of glaucoma and diabetes and the care and treatment of persons with glaucoma and diabetes. The program may include: Education of patients, health care personnel and the public; (1) Development and expansion of services to persons with glaucoma and (2) diabetes; and Provision of supplies, equipment and medication for detection and (3) control of glaucoma and diabetes. The Commission is authorized to adopt rules necessary to implement the (b)
