A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT REQUIRING THE CONSENT OF MACON COUNTY BEFORE LAND IN  
2 THAT COUNTY MAY BE CONDEMNED OR ACQUIRED BY A UNIT OF  
3 LOCAL GOVERNMENT OUTSIDE THE COUNTY.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 153A-15(c) reads as rewritten:

7 "(c) This section applies to Alleghany, Anson, Ashe, Bertie, Bladen, Brunswick,  
8 Burke, Buncombe, Caldwell, Caswell, Catawba, Cleveland, Columbus, Cumberland,  
9 Davidson, Davie, Duplin, Durham, Forsyth, Franklin, Gaston, Graham, Granville,  
10 Harnett, Haywood, Henderson, Hoke, Iredell, Jackson, Johnston, Lee, Lincoln, Macon,  
11 Madison, Martin, McDowell, Mecklenburg, Montgomery, New Hanover, Onslow,  
12 Pender, Person, Robeson, Rockingham, Rowan, Sampson, Scotland, Stokes, Surry,  
13 Swain, Transylvania, Union, Vance, Wake, Warren, Watauga, and Wilkes counties only.

14 This section does not apply as to any:

15 (1) Condemnation; or

16 (2) Acquisition of real property or an interest in real property

17 by a city where the property to be condemned or acquired is within the corporate limits of  
18 that city."

19 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
