2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO INCREASE EFFORTS FOR THE
3	PREVENTION OF AIDS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
6	Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000)
7	for the 1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1998-
8	99 fiscal year for community-based intervention efforts to combat the AIDS/HIV
9	epidemic. Funds appropriated under this section shall be allocated as follows:
10	(1) \$300,000 to increase, by over 600,000 persons, the capacity of existing
11	community-based organizations to provide outreach services to
12	individuals at risk for HIV/AIDS;
13	(2) \$300,000 to increase the capacity of local health departments in counties
14	where increased community-based organization efforts occur, for the
15	examination and treatment of persons referred by the community-based
16	organizations, and to establish alternate counseling and testing sites that
17	are based either at the local health department or at the community-
18	based organization;
19	(3) \$400,000 to provide funding for the development of new community-
20	based organizations to provide outreach and referral services for persons

1	at risk for HIV/AIDS. The primary focus of no fewer than one-half of
2	the community-based organizations developed with funds appropriated
3	in this section shall be services to racial and ethnic minority populations
4	across the State.
5	Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
