2	AN ACT TO ALLOW TAXPAYERS TO CONTRIBUTE INCOME TAX REFUNDS
3	FOR BREAST CANCER RESEARCH.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. Article 9 of Chapter 105 of the General Statutes is amended by
6	adding a new section to read:
7	"§ 105-269.7. Contribution of income tax refund for breast cancer research.
8	Any taxpayer entitled to a refund of income taxes under Division II of Article 4 of this
9	Chapter may elect to contribute all or part of the refund to be used for breast cancer
10	research at The University of North Carolina, Duke University, and Wake Forest
11	University. The Secretary shall provide appropriate language and space on the income
12	tax form in which to make the election. The Secretary shall include in the income tax
13	instructions an explanation that the contributions will be divided evenly between the
14	Lineberger Cancer Research Center at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill,
15	the Leo W. Jenkins Cancer Center at East Carolina University, the Duke Comprehensive
16	Cancer Center at Duke University, the Comprehensive Cancer Center at Wake Forest
17	University, and the Blumenthal Cancer Center at the Carolinas Medical Center in
18	Charlotte. The taxpayer's election becomes irrevocable upon filing the taxpayer's income

tax return for the taxable year. The Secretary shall transmit the contributions made 1 pursuant to this section to the State Treasurer to be distributed for breast cancer research. 2 3 The State Treasurer shall distribute the contributions equally among the Lineberger Cancer Research Center at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, the Leo W. 4 5 Jenkins Cancer Center at East Carolina University, the Duke Comprehensive Cancer Center at Duke University, the Comprehensive Cancer Center at Wake Forest University, 6 and the Blumenthal Cancer Center at the Carolinas Medical Center in Charlotte, which is 7 part of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Hospital Authority. Funds distributed pursuant to this 8 section shall be used only for breast cancer research." 9 Section 2. This act is effective for taxable years beginning on or after January 10 11 1, 1997.
