April 17, 1997 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO MODIFY THE MISSION OF THE RESIDENTIAL SUMMER PROGRAMS AT WESTERN CAROLINA UNIVERSITY AND AT EAST CAROLINA UNIVERSITY SO THEY MAY SERVE ACADEMICALLY GIFTED STUDENTS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. The residential summer school program operated by the Office of Rural Education, Western Carolina University, and the Rural Education Institute, East Carolina University, shall serve students who demonstrate that with extra motivation and opportunity they could become student leaders and that they should be given opportunities to develop their communications, problem-solving, and thinking skills, regardless of whether the students qualify for participation in programs designed to serve the academically gifted. Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
