SHORT TITLE: $\quad 82^{\text {nd }}$ Airborne Division Plates

BILL SUMMARY: The bill authorizes the Division of Motor Vehicles to issue $82^{\text {nd }}$ Airborne Division Association special registration plates.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY: Although there are 14,500 members of the $82^{\text {nd }}$ Airborne Division Association living in North Carolina, this fiscal note assumes the issuance of the minimum 500 license plates in FY 1997-98 and renewal of those plates in the following years. There is a one-time cost of $\$ 100$ to design the new plate and a one-time production cost of $\$ 2.45$ per plate. For 500 plates, the total production cost is $\$ 1,225$. In addition to the normal $\$ 20$ registration fee, there is a $\$ 10$ annual fee for each $82^{\text {nd }}$ Airborne Division plate that will be deposited into the Special Registration Plate Account within the Highway Fund. When additional Association members join, each additional plate issued will produce $\$ 10.00$ in recurring revenue and $\$ 2.45$ in one-time costs.
