AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A NO-WAKE SPEED ZONE IN GALLANT'S CHANNEL

NEAR RADIO ISLAND IN CARTERET COUNTY.

18 19 Section 1. It is unlawful to operate a vessel at greater than no-wake speed in Gallant's Channel in Carteret County from Duke Marine Laboratory's south docks to the rock jetty on the east side of Radio Island. No-wake speed is idle speed or a slow speed creating no appreciable wake.

Section 2. With regard to marking the no-wake speed zone, established in Section 1 of this act, Carteret County or its designee may place and maintain the markers in accordance with the Uniform Waterway Marking System and any supplementary standards from such a system adopted by the Wildlife Resources Commission. All markers of the no-wake speed zone shall be buoys or floating signs placed in the water and must be sufficient in number and size to give adequate warning of the no-wake speed zone to the vessels approaching from various directions.

Section 3. This act is enforceable under G.S. 75A-17 as if it were a provision of Chapter 75A of the General Statutes.

- Section 4. Violation of Section 1 of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor.
- Section 5. This act applies only to Carteret County.

Section 6. This act is effective when it becomes law and is enforceable after markers complying with Section 2 of this act are placed in the water.
