2	AN ACT TO CORRECT THE CANDIDATE FILING DEADLINE FOR THE ASHE
3	COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 128 of the 1995 Session Laws reads as
6	rewritten:
7	"Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 115C-37, the Ashe County Board
8	of Education shall be elected on a nonpartisan basis at the time set by G.S. 163-1 for the
9	general election in each even-numbered year as terms expire. The election shall be
10	conducted on a nonpartisan plurality basis, with the results determined in accordance
11	with G.S. 163-292. Candidates shall file notices of candidacy not earlier than noon on
12	the first Monday in June and not later than noon on the last-first Friday in July. The
13	names of the candidates shall be printed on the ballot without reference to any party
14	affiliations. Except as provided by this act, the election shall be conducted in accordance
15	with the applicable provisions of Chapters 115C and 163 of the General Statutes."
16	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
