5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. The Charter of the City of Durham, being Chapter 671 of the 1975
7	Session Laws, as amended, is further amended by adding a new section to read:
8	"Section 113.1. Statute of Limitations. G.S. 1-56 shall not apply to the City of
9	Durham. An action for relief not otherwise limited by Articles 3, 4, and 5 of Chapter 1 of
10	the General Statutes, or by other general or special laws establishing a limitations period
11	for specific types of actions, may not be commenced more than three years after the cause
12	of action has accrued."
13	Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
