A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF ROWLAND TO
2 PROVIDE THAT TOWN ELECTIONS SHALL BE CONDUCTED USING THE
3 NONPARTISAN PLURALITY METHOD.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Section 3.1 of the Charter of the Town of Rowland, being S.L.
7 1998-105, reads as rewritten:

8 "Section 3.1. **Regular Municipal Elections.** Regular municipal elections shall be
9 held in each odd-numbered year in accordance with the uniform municipal election laws
10 of North Carolina. Elections shall be conducted on a nonpartisan basis and the results
11 determined ~~using the nonpartisan election and runoff election method as provided in G.S. 163-~~
12 ~~279(a)(4) and G.S. 163-293.~~ by a plurality as provided in G.S. 163-292."

13 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
