A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO DIRECT THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION OVERSIGHT
COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE NEED FOR INSTRUCTION IN FOREIGN
LANGUAGES AT THE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LEVEL AND TO
APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE STUDY.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall study the need for instruction in foreign languages at the elementary school level. In the course of the study, the Committee shall consider the cost of providing instruction in foreign languages at the elementary school level, the impact of this instruction on the current curriculum, teacher training, and other related issues. The Committee shall report the results of its study to the 2001 General Assembly.

Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the General Assembly the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year for the study established in Section 1 of this act.

Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2000.
