1 A JOINT RESOLUTION HONORING THE LIFE AND MEMORY OF ALEXANDER  
2 DUKE "A. D."GUY, FORMER MEMBER OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

3 Whereas, Alexander Duke "A. D."Guy was born on November 20, 1918, in the  
4 Town of Calypso in Duplin County to Alexander Buck Guy and Elizabeth Faust Guy;  
5 and

6 Whereas, A. D. Guy graduated from Calypso High School in 1935 and  
7 furthered his education through courses at North Carolina State University and the  
8 University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill; and

9 Whereas, A. D. Guy served his community as a member of the Jacksonville  
10 City Council, as Mayor of the City of Jacksonville, and as a member of the Onslow  
11 County Board of Commissioners; and

12 Whereas, A. D. Guy served as a member of the House of Representatives from  
13 1979 to 1982 and as a member of the Senate from 1983 to 1991, where he contributed  
14 greatly to the work of the General Assembly by ably serving as a member and chair of  
15 several committees; and

16 Whereas, A. D. Guy was an insurance agent and realtor; and

17 Whereas, A. D. Guy was a member of numerous professional boards and  
18 organizations, including the Independent Insurance Agents of North Carolina, North  
19 Carolina Association of Realtors, National Association for Real Estate Boards, and the  
20 Jacksonville Board of Realtors; and

21 Whereas, A. D. Guy was active in numerous civic and fraternal organizations  
22 in his community, serving as a member of the Loyal Order of the Moose and Jacksonville

1 Toastmasters, President of the Jacksonville Rotary Club, President of the Onslow County  
2 Chapter of the American Cancer Society, Campaign Chair of the American Red Cross  
3 Society, founder of the Jacksonville Municipal Court, and founder of the First Biracial  
4 Committee in the City of Jacksonville; and

5         Whereas, A. D. Guy also made contributions as a member of the Onslow  
6 Memorial Hospital Authority, Board of Directors of the North Carolina League of  
7 Municipalities, Board of Directors of the Home Federal Savings and Loan Association,  
8 Board of Directors of the North Carolina Retail Merchants Association, Governor's  
9 Committee of Mayor's Co-Operating Committee, Atlantic State Marine Fisheries  
10 Commission, and the Committee on Commerce, Labor, and Regulation of the National  
11 Conference of State Legislatures State-Federal Assembly; and

12         Whereas, A. D. Guy was a faithful member of the Trinity United Methodist  
13 Church, serving on the Board of Trustees, the Administrative Board, the Fund Raising  
14 Campaign for Christian Higher Education, and as a member of the Staff Parish Relations  
15 Committee; and

16         Whereas, A. D. Guy was highly respected by his colleagues and the members  
17 of his community; and

18         Whereas, A. D. Guy died on March 14, 1998; and

19         Whereas, A. D. Guy was married to the former Margaret Holmes Guy, who  
20 preceded him in death, and is survived by his sons: Alexander D. Guy Jr., Bundage H.  
21 Guy, and Douglas B. Guy; a stepson, Dennis Guthrie; five grandchildren: Alexander  
22 Duke Guy III, Mallary W. Guy, Megan Jeaneal Guy, Bundage Jordan Guy, and Douglas  
23 Taylor Guy; and three stepgrandchildren: Christopher Neil Adkins, Alexa Kay  
24 McMurtrey, and Jason Guthrie; Now, therefore,  
25 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

26         Section 1. The General Assembly expresses its deep appreciation for the life  
27 and accomplishments of Alexander Duke "A. D."Guy and for the outstanding service he  
28 rendered to the State of North Carolina, the County of Onslow, and the City of  
29 Jacksonville.

30         Section 2. The General Assembly extends its deepest sympathy to the family  
31 of Alexander Duke "A. D."Guy for the loss of their beloved father, grandfather, and  
32 friend.

33         Section 3. The Secretary of State shall transmit a certified copy of this  
34 resolution to the family of Alexander Duke "A. D."Guy.

35         Section 4. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
