A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO REDUCE THE AFTER-FACTORY WINDOW TINTING INSPECTION
FEE FOR PERSONS WITH DOCUMENTED MEDICAL CONDITIONS THAT
REQUIRE WINDOW TINTING.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 20-183.7(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Fee Amount. – When a fee applies to an inspection of a vehicle or the issuance of an inspection sticker, the fee must be collected. The following fees apply to an inspection of a vehicle and the issuance of an inspection sticker:

Safety Only, Without After-		
Factory Tinted Window	\$ 8.25	\$ 1.00
Safety Only, With After-Factory Tinted		
Window	18.25	1.00
Emissions and Safety Without After-Factory		
Tinted Window	17.00	2.40
Emissions and Safety With After-Factory		
Tinted Window	27.00	2.40.

1 The fee for performing an inspection of a vehicle applies when an inspection is
2 performed, regardless of whether the vehicle passes the inspection. The fee for an
3 inspection sticker applies when an inspection sticker is put on a vehicle. The fee for
4 performing an inspection of a vehicle with a tinted window applies only to an inspection
5 performed with a light meter after a safety inspection mechanic determined that the
6 window had after-factory tint.

7 A vehicle that is inspected at an inspection station and fails the inspection is entitled
8 to be reinspected at the same station at any time within 30 days of the failed inspection
9 without paying another inspection fee.

10 The fee for after-factory tinting inspection shall be reduced by five dollars (\$5.00) for
11 any vehicle owner with a documented medical condition that requires after-factory tinted
12 windows."

13 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
