### A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT EXTENDING THE TOWN OF CHOCOWINITY'S EXTRATERRITORIAL3 JURISDICTION.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. In addition to any areas where the Town of Chocowinity exercises 6 extraterritorial jurisdiction under Article 19 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes, the 7 Town shall have extraterritorial jurisdiction under that Article in the following described 8 area, which includes the Cypress Landing Subdivision:

BEGINNING at the existing Extraterritorial Jurisdiction at the southeast corner of the 9 Margaret Louise Barr property, otherwise known as Parcel number 5674-31-1415 on the 10 Beaufort County Land Records; thence from said point in a southeasterly direction 11 following the right-of-way of Norfolk Southern Railroad to the southeast corner of the 12 Weyerhaeuser Real Estate Company property, otherwise known as Parcel number 5674-13 83-5374 on the Beaufort County Land Records; thence from said point in a 14 north/northeasterly direction following the eastern property line of the Weyerhaeuser 15 Real Estate Company property, otherwise known as Parcel number 5674-83-5374 on the 16 Beaufort County Land Records, to the right-of-way of SR 1123; thence from said point in 17 a southeasterly direction following the right-of-way of SR 1123 to the southeastern 18 corner of the Curtis Earl Grist and Sharon Grist property, otherwise known as Parcel 19

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number 5683-18-6341 on the Beaufort County Land Records; thence from said point in a 1 2 northeasterly direction following the eastern property line of the Curtis Earl Grist and 3 Sharon Grist property, otherwise known as Parcel number 5683-18-6341 on the Beaufort 4 County Land Records, to the northeast corner of said Parcel; thence from said point in a 5 northeasterly direction following the eastern property line of the Addie Grist property, 6 otherwise known as Parcel number 5683-18-8615 on the Beaufort County Land Records. 7 to the northeastern corner of said Parcel; thence from said point in a varying easterly and 8 northeasterly direction following the northern property line of the Charlotte Stokes Garris 9 property, otherwise known as Parcel number 5683-28-9280 on the Beaufort County Tax 10 Records, to the property line of the James Bragg Robertson, Jr. property, otherwise known as Parcel number 5683-48-4138 on the Beaufort County Tax Records; thence 11 12 from said point in a northeasterly direction following the western property line of the James Bragg Robertson, Jr. property, otherwise known as Parcel number 5683-48-4138, 13 14 to the mouth of Rice Creek; thence from said point in a generally northwesterly direction 15 following the southern bank of Chocowinity Bay to the existing Extraterritorial Jurisdiction at the intersection of the right-of-way of Norfolk Southern Railroad and the 16 17 center of Crawford Creek.

18 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
