11	through the Statewide Automated Victim Assistance and Notification System established
12	by the Governor's Crime Commission, does not create a claim for damages against the
13	State, a county, or a municipality, or any of its agencies, instrumentalities, officers, or
14	employees."
15	Section 2. Effective July 1, 1999, G.S. 15A-840 reads as rewritten:
16	"§ 15A-840. No ground for relief.

GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF NORTH CAROLINA

The failure or inability of any person to provide a right or service under this Article 1 Article, including a service provided through the Statewide Automated Victim Assistance 2 and Notification System established by the Governor's Crime Commission, may not be 3 used by a defendant in a criminal case, by an inmate, by any other accused, or by any 4 victim, as a ground for relief in any criminal or civil proceeding, except in suits for a writ 5 of mandamus by the victim." 6 7

Section 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
