April 15, 1999 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DURHAM ARTS COUNCIL FOR AN ARTS AND SCIENCE CULTURAL PLAN. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year to be allocated to the Durham Arts Council for an Arts and Science Cultural Plan. The Plan will allow for the study of arts and cultural resources in the City of Durham and for the creation of a model that could be used throughout the State to align cultural resources with the expectations of visitors and of new and relocating businesses. Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
