A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW TO ALLOW COUNTIES TO REDUCE CERTAIN
2 COUNTY APPROPRIATIONS AND EXPENDITURES FOR AREA MENTAL
3 HEALTH AUTHORITIES FOR FUTURE FISCAL YEARS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 122C-115(d) reads as rewritten:

7 "(d) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, Counties-counties shall not
8 reduce county appropriations and expenditures for current operations and ongoing
9 programs and services of area authorities because of the availability of State-allocated
10 funds, fees, capitation amounts, or fund balance to the area authority. Counties may
11 reduce county appropriations by the amount previously appropriated by the county for
12 one-time, nonrecurring special needs of the area authority."

13 Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
