2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY
3	COLLEGES FOR A FAMILY LITERACY PROGRAM.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. The Department of Community Colleges shall develop and
6	establish a family literacy program. The purpose of the program shall be to:
7	(1) Raise the educational level of parents, including raising their basic and
8	English language skills, and help them gain the motivation, skills, and
9	knowledge necessary to become employed or to reach a higher level of
10	employment.
11	(2) Increase the developmental abilities of young children and better
12	prepare them for success in school through the provision of age-
13	appropriate curricula and environments.
14	(3) Improve parenting skills through parent education and parent support
15	groups.
16	(4) Enhance the parent-child relationship by providing an opportunity for
17	parents and children to interact together in a positive and supportive
18	environment.
19	The Department shall develop guidelines for the program, including guidelines
20	for providing services that provide education to both parents and children and that

- promote parent-child interaction on a meaningful level. The guidelines shall also include
 eligibility criteria for participants in the program.
- 3 Section 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
- 4 Community Colleges the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1999-
- 5 2000 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2000-
- 6 2001 fiscal year to develop a family literacy program pursuant to this act.
- 7 Section 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
