- 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE ACCELERATED SCHOOLS 3 PROGRAM.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State Board of 6 Education the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the 1999-2000 7 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the 2000-8 2001 fiscal year to strengthen and expand the Accelerated Schools Program in North 9 Carolina public schools. Of these funds:

- 10(1)The sum of \$60,000 for each fiscal year shall be used by the Department11of Public Instruction to provide support to schools implementing the12Program, and
- The sum of \$90,000 for each fiscal year shall be used to provide 13 (2)coaches for accelerated schools and for professional development for 14 teachers on designing and implementing instructional strategies to (i) 15 enhance students' content knowledge in reading, writing, and 16 mathematics, (ii) build students' skills in imaginative and critical 17 thinking and complex reasoning, and (iii) enhance students' ability to 18 understand connections and relevance between school activities and 19 their lives outside of the classroom. Professional development activities 20

shall be based on strategies traditionally reserved for academically
gifted students and on strategies for improving the academic
performance of all students.
Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
