Short Title: Amend Bill Lee Act Tier Designations.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT AN ENTERPRISE TIER TWO AREA MAY NOT BE
2 REDESIGNATED AS A HIGHER-NUMBERED TIER AREA UNTIL IT HAS
3 BEEN AN ENTERPRISE TIER TWO AREA FOR TWO CONSECUTIVE YEARS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 105-129.3(c) reads as rewritten:

6 "(c) Exception for Enterprise Tier One and Two Areas. – Notwithstanding the
7 provisions of this section, a county designated as an enterprise tier one area or an
8 enterprise tier two area may not be redesignated as a higher-numbered enterprise tier area
9 until it has been ~~an~~ in its enterprise tier ~~one~~ area for at least two consecutive years."

10 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and, notwithstanding G.S.
11 105-129.3(b), applies retroactively to designations for the 2000 and later calendar years.
