Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration the sum of four million seven hundred forty thousand dollars (\$4,740,000) in recurring funds for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to be allocated to the North Carolina Council for Women for the continuation of domestic violence programs within the State. Of these funds, the North Carolina Council for Women shall allocate sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) to each of the 78 existing domestic violence programs and to the North Carolina Coalition Against Domestic Violence, Inc.

Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 150B-21.1(a), the Section 2. Department of Administration may adopt temporary rules to approve abuser treatment programs that apply to the North Carolina Council for Women.

Section 3. Section 1 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2000. Section 2 of this act is effective when it becomes law.
