A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE INVESTIGATIONS OF
SUDDEN UNEXPECTED DEATHS OF INFANTS AND YOUNG CHILDREN.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Women's and Children's Health, the sum of one hundred ninety thousand four hundred dollars (\$190,400) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year to start up and operate improved, intensive investigation of sudden unexpected deaths of infants and young children. These investigations shall include adequate death scene examinations and historical inquiry as well as autopsies, with appropriate ancillary studies.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
