March 8, 1999 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE NORTH CAROLINA GEOGRAPHIC ALLIANCE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year and the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 2000-2001 fiscal year to support the North Carolina Geographic Alliance, which is headquartered at East Carolina University. These funds shall be matched on a one-to-one basis and shall be used to: Increase communication and cooperation between the professional (1) geographic community within the University of North Carolina system and the Alliance network of teachers. Develop a North Carolina Geographic Alliance web site on Learning (2) Link in cooperation with UNC-TV. Increase the numbers of geography/Standard Course of Study in-service (3) workshops conducted by professional geographers and Alliance teachers
