March 8, 1999 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO MAKE PERMANENT THE PROHIBITION OF THE RELEASE OF CERTAIN PERSONAL INFORMATION BY THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Section 17.1 of S.L. 1998-23, as amended by Section 27.18(a) of S.L. 1998-212, reads as rewritten: "Section 17.1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Division of Motor Vehicles shall not disclose personal information in its records for purposes specified in 18 U.S.C. § 2721(b)(12) prior to January 1, 2000. This section shall not expire until January 1, 2000.-18 U.S.C. § 2721(b)(12)." Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
