- Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the prevention of suicide in North Carolina. The study may include the incidence of youth and adult suicide and attempted suicide in this State, intervention and prevention strategies currently in place, and other intervention and prevention strategies the State may adopt to decrease the incidence of suicide among North Carolinians.
- Section 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim report to the 1999 General Assembly, 2000 Regular Session, and shall make a final report to the 2001 General Assembly.
 - Section 3. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
