2	AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE CAMDEN, CHEROKEE, CURRITUCK, GRAHAM,
3	HAYWOOD, JACKSON, MADISON, PASQUOTANK, PERQUIMANS, AND
4	SWAIN COUNTIES TO REQUIRE THE PAYMENT OF DELINQUENT
5	PROPERTY TAXES BEFORE RECORDING DEEDS CONVEYING PROPERTY.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Article 2 of Chapter 161 of the General Statutes is amended by
8	adding a new section to read:
9	" <u>§ 161-31. Tax certification.</u>
10	The board of commissioners of a county may, by resolution, require the register of
11	deeds not to accept any deed for registration unless the county tax collector has certified
12	that no delinquent ad valorem county taxes, ad valorem municipal taxes, or taxes with
13	which the collector is charged are a lien on the property described in the deed."
14	SECTION 2. This act applies only to Camden, Cherokee, Currituck,
15	Graham, Haywood, Jackson, Madison, Pasquotank, Perquimans, and Swain Counties.
16	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
