Authority from the Trust Fund each year, no more than three percent (3%) may be used

- by the Department for operating expenses associated with managing capital improvements projects, acquiring land, and administration of local grants programs."
- 3 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to grants 4 awarded on or after that date.
