## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES TO VETERANS OF WORLD WAR II, THE KOREAN WAR, AND THE UNITED STATES NAVY SUBMARINE SERVICE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-79.4(b) reads as rewritten:
"(b) Types. - The Division shall issue the following types of special registration plates:
(20b) Korean War Veteran. - Issuable to a veteran of the armed forces of the United States who served during the Korean Conflict, which began June 27, 1950, and ended January 31, 1955. The plate shall bear the words "Korean War Veteran" and a representation of the Republic of Korea Service Medal. The Division may not issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300 applications for the plate."
(46a) U.S. Navy Specialty. - Issuable to a veteran of the United States Navy Submariner Service. The plate shall bear the phrase "Silent Service Veteran" and shall bear a representation of the Submarine Service Qualification pin. The Division may not issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300 applications for the plate."
(52) World War II. - Issuable to a veteran of the armed forces of the United States who served during World War II, which began December 7, 1941, and ended December 31, 1946, or to the veteran's spouse. The plate shall bear the words "World War II Veteran" and shall bear a representation of the National Iwo Jima Monument. The Division may
not issue the plate authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300 applications for the plate."
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
