2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT MALE RESIDENTS AGE EIGHTEEN THROUGH
3 TWENTY-FIVE COMPLY WITH THE SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM'S
4 REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS WHEN APPLYING FOR A DRIVERS
5 LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD AND TO MAKE STATEWIDE A
6 LOCAL ACT TO PERMIT THE REMOVAL OF FILED DD FORM 214 AND
7 OTHER DISCHARGE PAPERS OR FOR THE REDACTING OF THE FORM OR
8 FORMS WHEN A COPY IS REQUESTED BY PERSONS OTHER THAN THE
9 FILER OR A MEMBER OF HIS FAMILY, WHICH CURRENTLY APPLIES
10 ONLY IN CRAVEN, NASH, AND PAMLICO COUNTIES.

11 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

12 **SECTION 1.** Article 2 of Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by
13 adding a new section to read:

14 **"§ 20-9.2. Selective service system registration requirements.**

15 (a) Any male United States citizen or immigrant who is at least 18 years of age
16 but less than 26 years of age shall be registered in compliance with the requirements of
17 the Military Selective Service Act, 50 U.S.C. § 453 (1948), when applying for the
18 issuance, renewal, or duplication of a drivers license, commercial drivers license, or
19 identification card.

20 (b) The Division shall forward in an electronic format the necessary personal
21 information of the applicants identified in subsection (a) of this section required for
22 registration to the Selective Service System. An application for the issuance, renewal, or
23 duplication of a drivers license, commercial drivers license, or identification card
24 constitutes an affirmation that the applicant has already registered with the Selective
25 Service System or that he authorizes the Division to forward the necessary information

1 to the Selective Service System for registration. The Division shall notify the applicant
2 that his application for the issuance, renewal, or duplication of a drivers license,
3 commercial drivers license, or identification card serves as his consent to be registered
4 with the Selective Service System pursuant to this section."

5 **SECTION 1.1.** Section 3 of S.L. 2002-96 is repealed.

6 **SECTION 2.** The Division of Motor Vehicles shall implement the
7 requirements of this act at the earliest practical date, but no later than April 1, 2003.

8 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
