SECTION 1. G.S. 160A-58.1(b) reads as rewritten:		
"(b) A noncontiguous area proposed for annexation must meet all of the following		
standards:		
(1)	The nearest point on the proposed satellite corporate limits more than three miles from the primary corporate li annexing city.	
(2)	No point on the proposed satellite corporate limits may be primary corporate limits of another city than to the prima limits of the annexing city.	
(3)	The area must be so situated that the annexing city will provide the same services within the proposed satellite corthat it provides within its primary corporate limits.
