A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO GRANT
2 WAIVERS FOR SCHOOLS THAT ARE UNABLE TO IMPLEMENT THE
3 HIGH-PRIORITY SCHOOL PROGRAM FOR THE 2002-2003 FISCAL YEAR
4 AND TO USE FUNDS SAVED AS A RESULT OF THE WAIVERS TO OFFSET
5 BASE BUDGET REDUCTIONS IN THE STATE PUBLIC SCHOOL FUND.
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7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** Section 29.6(c) of S.L. 2001-424 reads as rewritten:

9 "**SECTION 29.6.(c)** If a local board of education determines that the local school
10 administrative unit is unable to implement the class-size limitation in accordance with
11 this section for any high-priority school located in the unit, the local board may request
12 a waiver for the school for the 2001-2002 school ~~year-year~~ and for the 2002-2003
13 school year. The request shall include the documentation required in G.S.
14 115C-105.26(a). If the State Board grants the waiver, the State Board shall withdraw the
15 additional teacher positions allotted to the local school administrative unit for the school
16 and reinstate the regular allotment for teacher assistants for the school."

17 **SECTION 2.** Each waiver granted pursuant to Section 1 of this act will
18 reduce expenditures of State funds at the school by an amount in excess of one hundred
19 thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2002-2003 fiscal year. The State Board of
20 Education shall use these savings to offset base budget reductions in the State Public
21 School Fund for the 2002-2003 fiscal year.

22 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2002, but becomes effective
23 only if Senate Bill 1115, 2001 Session becomes law and either reenacts Section 1 of this
24 act or contains language identical to Section 1 of this act.
