| SECTION 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the |
| following aspects of the operations of the North Carolina State Ports Authority |
| facilities: |
| (1) The reestablishment of competitive intermodal rail services at the |
| North Carolina State Ports Authority facilities. |
| (2) Support efforts to recruit wholesale and retail distribution centers |
| utilizing the North Carolina Ports. |
| (3) The reinstatement of passenger cruise service in Morehead City and |
| Wilmington. |
| SECTION 2. If this study is undertaken, the Legislative Research |
| Commission shall file a final report on this study to the 2003 General Assembly. |

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
