A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN DISCLOSURE TO AND 3 SUMMARY PLAN INFORMATION FOR PROSPECTIVE INSUREDS. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Article 3 of Chapter 58 of the General Statutes is amended by 5 adding a new section to read: 6 7 "§ 58-3-240. Health benefit plan disclosure and summary plan information. An insurer shall provide every prospective applicant and prospective enrollee with a 8 9 clear and concise description of the coverage provided by the insurer's health benefit plan. The description shall be printed on a form prescribed by the Commissioner. The 10 description shall specify: 11 Definitions of terms used in the health benefit plan. 12 (1) A brief description of the principal benefits and coverage provided, 13 (2) including any coverage exclusions or limitations. 14 brief description of how coverage determinations are made, 15 (3) including whether factors other than medical necessity and coverage 16 17 exclusions and limitations are considered. A brief explanation of insurer and insured payment responsibilities, 18 (4) including how plan allowances, such as 'usual and customary charges', 19 are developed. 20 A brief explanation of provider network limitations and requirements, 21 **(5)** including requirements for the use of sub-networks, prior authorization 22 or precertification, and the arrangements of tertiary and quaternary 23 24 care.
