1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE NORTH CAROLINA BOARD OF ELECTROLYSIS
3 EXAMINERS TO ESTABLISH NEW FEES AND INCREASE CERTAIN
4 CURRENT FEES AND AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS UNDER THE
5 ELECTROLYSIS PRACTICE ACT RELATING TO FEES.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 88A-9(b) reads as rewritten:

8 "(b) All fees may be calculated by the Board in amounts sufficient to pay the costs
9 of administration of this act, but in no event may they exceed the following:

27 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 88A-10 reads as rewritten:

28 "**§ 88A-10. Requirements for licensure as an electrologist.**"

1 (a) Any person who desires to be licensed as an "electrologist" pursuant to this
2 Chapter shall:

- 3 (1) Submit an application on a form approved by the ~~Board;~~Board.
- 4 (2) Be a resident of North ~~Carolina;~~Carolina.
- 5 (3) Be 18 years of age or ~~older;~~older.
- 6 (4) Meet the requirements of subsection (a1) of this ~~section;~~ and section.
- 7 (5) Pass an examination given by the Board.
- 8 (6) Submit the application and examination fees required in G.S. 88A-9(b).

9 (a1) An applicant for licensure under this section shall provide:

- 10 (1) Proof of graduation from a school certified by the Board pursuant to
11 G.S. 88A-19; or
- 12 (2) Proof satisfactory to the Board that, for at least one year prior to the
13 date of application or the date of initial residence in this State,
14 whichever is earlier, the applicant was engaged in the practice of
15 electrology in a state that does not license electrologists.

16 Subdivision (2) of this subsection applies only to applicants whose residence in this
17 State began on or after January 31, 1994, who do not meet the qualifications of
18 subdivision (1) of this subsection or G.S. 88A-12.

19 (b) At least twice each year, the Board shall give an examination to applicants for
20 licensure to determine the applicants' knowledge of the basic and clinical sciences
21 relating to the theory and practice of electrology. The Board shall give applicants notice
22 of the date, time, and place of the examination at least 60 days in advance.

23 (c) When the Board determines that an applicant has met all the
24 qualifications requirements for licensure, and has submitted the ~~required fee;~~ initial license
25 fee required in G.S. 88A-9(b). the Board shall issue a license to the applicant.

26 (d) An applicant otherwise qualified for licensure who is not a resident of this
27 State may nevertheless submit a statement of intent to begin practicing electrology in this
28 State and receive a license. The applicant must provide to the Board within six months of
29 receiving a license evidence satisfactory to the Board that the applicant has actually
30 begun to practice electrology in this State. The Board may revoke the license of an
31 applicant who fails to submit this proof or whose proof fails to satisfy the Board."

32 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 88A-14 reads as rewritten:

33 **"§ 88A-14. Inactive list.**

34 Upon request by a licensee for inactive status, the Board shall place the licensee's
35 name on the inactive list. While on the inactive list, the person shall not be subjected to
36 renewal requirements and shall not practice electrology in North Carolina. When that
37 person desires to be removed from the inactive list and returned to an active list, ~~an a~~
38 reactivation application shall be submitted to the Board on a form furnished by the Board
39 and the fee shall be paid for license ~~renewal;~~ reactivation. The Board may require
40 evidence of competency to resume practice before returning the applicant to the active
41 status. Any person whose license has lapsed or expired for a period of five years or more
42 shall be required to take and pass the examination for licensure before the license can be
43 ~~renewed;~~ reactivated."

1 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2001.
