The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 160A-301 is amended by adding a new s	ubsection to
read:	
"(b1) A city may by ordinance require pretowing notices to be displayed	ed on private
lots, garages, or other parking facilities before vehicles parked there	without the
permission of the owner or lessee may be towed or removed. The city may	set the size
and nature of the required notices and provide penalties for violating the ordinance."	

**SECTION 2.** This act applies to the City of Greenville only.

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
