1 A JOINT RESOLUTION HONORING THE MEMORY OF MRS. FRANK WOODS,  
2 MRS. HUNDLEY GOVER, MRS. W. STEWART PEERY, MRS. WILLIAM H.  
3 MEANOR, MRS. BRUCE A. BEERY, AND MRS. LEE A. THORNBURG,  
4 FORMER PRESIDENTS OF THE CHARLOTTE SYMPHONY GUILD UPON  
5 THE GUILD'S FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY.

6       Whereas, The Symphony Guild of Charlotte is dedicated to youth music  
7 education through its many projects which offer young people throughout the Charlotte  
8 Metropolitan Area varied opportunities to experience classical music; and

9       Whereas, The Symphony Guild of Charlotte has supported The Charlotte  
10 Symphony Youth Orchestra and The Junior Youth Orchestra, solely underwritten The  
11 Summer Resident Music Camp for over 30 years, and sponsored The Young Artists  
12 Competition for over 20 years and The Youth Festival for 14 years; and

13       Whereas, The Guild's projects, in particular, The Summer Resident Music  
14 Camp, The Youth Festival, and The Symphony Guild ASID Showhouse, have received  
15 national recognition by The American Symphony Orchestra League and serve as  
16 models for other nonprofit organizations throughout the nation; and

17       Whereas, The Guild was recognized locally for its long, continuous  
18 commitment to the cultural fabric of the Charlotte community with the prestigious Spirit  
19 Award from Royal and SunAlliance and The Mint Museum; and

20       Whereas, the week of April 1, 2001, has been declared The Symphony Guild  
21 Music Education Week in the City of Charlotte; and

22       Whereas, under the leadership of its current president and of its former  
23 presidents, The Guild is celebrating 50 years of support for symphonic music; Now,  
24 therefore,

25 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

26       **SECTION 1.** The General Assembly honors the memory of Mrs. Frank  
27 Woods, Mrs. Hundley Gover, Mrs. W. Stewart Peery, Mrs. William H. Meanor, Mrs.  
28 Bruce A. Beery, and Mrs. Lee A. Thornburg for their role in leading The Symphony

1 Guild of Charlotte. The General Assembly expresses its appreciation to The Symphony  
2 Guild of Charlotte for its dedication to youth music education and congratulates The  
3 Guild on its 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary.
