Short Title: Air/Heating Contractors Amendment. (Public) **Sponsors:** Representatives Allred and Cole (By Request) (Primary Sponsors). Referred to: Ways and Means. March 26, 2001 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO ALLOW CERTAIN LICENSED HEATING CONTRACTORS TO INSTALL AIR CONDITIONING SYSTEMS IF NO INDIVIDUAL UNIT IN THE SYSTEM EXCEEDS FIFTEEN TONS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 87-21(b) reads as rewritten: Classes of Licenses; Eligibility and Examination of Applicant; Necessity for "(b) License. – Any person issued a license by the Board to install a system in heating, (5a) group number three, as defined in G.S. 87-21(a)(4), may also install a system in heating, group number two, as defined in G.S. 87-21(a)(3), without having to obtain a license in that classification, if no individual unit of the air conditioning system has a mechanical refrigeration capacity in excess of 15 tons."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
