2 AN ACT TO MAKE A TECHNICAL CORRECTION TO THE SECTION OF THE
3 CHARTER OF THE CITY OF DURHAM THAT PROVIDES EXEMPTIONS
4 FROM THE CITY'S FAIR HOUSING ORDINANCE, TO EXPAND THE
5 DURHAM COUNTY ABC BOARD TO FIVE MEMBERS, AND ALLOW THE
6 CITY OF DURHAM TO USE THE SINGLE-PRIME CONTRACT SYSTEM FOR
7 THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A TRANSFER FACILITY AND
8 PARKING DECK.

9 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

10 **SECTION 1.** Section 122(5)b. of the Charter of the City of Durham, being
11 Chapter 671 of the 1975 Session Laws, as amended, is further amended by deleting the
12 phrase "not less than sixty (60) days" and substituting the phrase "not more than sixty
13 (60) days."

14 **SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding G.S. 18B-700, the Durham County ABC
15 Board consists of five members. The two additional board members authorized by this
16 act shall be appointed by the Board of Commissioners of Durham County. The initial
17 terms of office of those two members shall be established by the Board of
18 Commissioners of Durham County for a duration not to exceed three years. Successors
19 shall serve three-year terms as provided by G.S. 18B-700.

20 **SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding the provisions of G.S. 143-128(a)-(e) and (g),
21 143-129, 143-131, and 143-132, the City of Durham may enter into contracts for the
22 design and construction of a multimodal transit transfer facility and a parking deck to
23 serve the facility using the single-prime contract system.

24 **SECTION 4.** Section 3 of this act applies to the City of Durham only.

25 **SECTION 5.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
