2	AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON TO
3	IMPOSE TERM LIMITS ON THE MEMBERS OF THE CITY'S UTILITIES
4	COMMISSION.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Section 7.2.B of the Charter of the City of Lexington, being
7	Chapter 906 of the 1981 Session Laws, as amended, reads as rewritten:
8	"B. All appointments made thereafter as terms expire shall be for terms of three
9	years. No member of the Lexington Utilities Commission shall serve for more than two
10	consecutive full terms without an intervening period of three years. Appointment for the
11	unexpired portion of a term shall not be considered appointment for a full term."
12	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
